Sub- Inviting project proposals under AIISH research funding – reg.

All India Institute of Speech and Hearing an autonomous body under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India invites research project proposals from **Group A and Group B** professionals in the field of speech, language, Hearing and other allied areas of neurosciences, linguistics, acoustics, biomedical, electronics, clinical psychology, genetics, rehabilitation sciences, special education, otolaryngology etc. for the second cycle of the **year 2022-2023 (2nd Cycle)** to be funded under AIISH Research Fund.

The detailed guidelines for submission of project proposals, eligibility etc. and the formats are available in the institute website 'www.aiishmysore.in' under **Research**. As a quality initiative out of the ARF research proposals received for the year, the AIISH Research Evaluation Committee (AREC) would consider sanction of one major project for two years duration from this year apart from sanction of other projects for duration of one year.

The project proposal in the area of Speech, Languages, Hearing and other allied areas, may be **submitted on or before 30.08.2022** for further necessary action. The thrust area of research for the second cycle of 2022-2023 are


1. Development of tools for offline/online/virtual based tele-assessment and its effectiveness
2. Performance with implantable hearing devices including CI
3. Development of offline/tele-rehabilitation therapy modules
4. Development of aids and appliances/technology for offline/tele-rehabilitation of persons with communication disorders.
5. Development Apps for screening of communication disorders
6. Development of holistic (multi – disciplinary) approaches for the management of various communication disorders
7. Awareness of communication disorders among general public/medical professionals
8. Identifying risk factors for congenital hearing loss in India
9. Role of screening programs of communication disorders in reducing the burden of disability on society
10. Epidemiological research related to communication disorders.
11. Evidence based research
12. Assessment of intelligence and adaptive behaviour
13. Behaviour modification
14. Service evaluation and audit.

Further, the researchers who have been sanctioned ARF projects previously are hereby informed to

- Indicate the status of completion of ARF project sanctioned to them during the previous five year in the prescribed format titled Format for Research proposal (download from www.aiishmysore.in) under **Research**
- Indicate the progress made in the ARF project sanctioned to them during the year 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 by mentioning the milestone achieved.
- The PI(s) / CI (S) can involve only in maximum of two projects as either PI/CI during the current year including any pending project sanctioned during the previous years.
- The role of PI(s) and CI(s) should be delineated and specified for each project signed by PI and CI respectively, while forwarding the hard copy and soft copy proposal.

It may be noted that the information in respect of the above ***should be attached for each of the pending project/s*** along with fresh proposals being submitted by the researchers' ***failing which the fresh proposals would not be taken for consideration.***
