

Master of Education Special Education (Hearing Impairment) - M.Ed. Spl. Ed. (HI) (Affiliated to University of Mysore & Recognized by RCI)

Duration of the Program : Two years (Four semesters)
Total number of Seats : 20

Scope of the program: The aim of the M.Ed.Spl.Ed. programme is of preparing teachers as education leaders. The major thrust of the M.Ed.Spl.Ed. programme would be professional preparation of teacher educators who would through this process be equipped with the knowledge and competencies to facilitate and conduct initial preparation and continuing professional development of teachers in the area of communication disorders.

Employment opportunities: The master's degree holders will work as leaders to special teachers/educators who can deliver the best in all settings: inclusive, special, open or home based and in all the roles: classroom teacher, resource teacher, itinerant teacher or cross disability teacher facilitators.

Admission Eligibility

- 1) Candidate who has successfully passed B.Ed. Spl. Ed. (HI) degree of the University of Mysore or any B.Ed. (HI) recognized by RCI of any other University considered as equivalent thereto with an average of not less than 50% of marks in the qualifying examination are eligible. At the time of admission, student should produce Degree Certificate as per the University of Mysore guidelines with RCI registration.
- 2) Candidate who has successfully passed the B.Ed. General course and as successfully completed Diploma in Education Special Education (HI) recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India with minimum 50% marks in each program.
- 3) A student with B.A/B.Sc./B.Com. B.Ed.Spl.Ed.(HI) (4 years integrated).
- 4) Candidate should have valid RCI registration.

Mode of Selection

For selection of candidates, entrance examination will be conducted at AIISH based on B.S.Ed. (HI) / B.Ed. Spl. Ed. (HI) syllabus of RCI. Admission shall be made only on the basis of rank in the entrance examination of AIISH. The number of questions to be answered shall be 50 in duration of 50 minutes. There will be no negative marking for wrong answers. In case of tie, older candidates will be placed at higher merit position.

Stipend: ₹650/- per month for 10 months

Note:

I. From within the General Merit seats, one seat is allotted to an eligible candidate with Physical Disability, as defined by the RPWD Act 2016. In case, the seat is not filled under the PWD category, it would be filled by a candidate from the general category.

1. Candidates with the benchmark disabilities listed in the schedule of the RPWD Act, 2016 (UDID/competent medical board certification) are eligible to avail PWD quota for admission at AIISH, provided:
 - a. With the aid of assistive devices, the specified disability is brought to 40% or below.
 - b. Speech, Language and Hearing disability are brought to 20% or below with the aid of assistive devices & / or training. Speech, Language and Hearing disability should be assessed by a duly constituted board by the Director, AIISH.
2. Candidates with less than benchmark disabilities listed in the schedule of the RPWD Act, 2016 can be admitted to the program (however, not under PWD quota) courses at AIISH, provided:
 - a. Speech, Language and Hearing disability is brought to 20% or below with the aid of assistive devices & / or training. Speech, Language and Hearing disability should be assessed by a duly constituted board by the Director, AIISH.
