All India Institute of Speech and Hearing, an autonomous institute under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, was established on 9th August, 1965.

About TCPD

Tele-Center for Persons with communication Disorders (TCPD) was launched by the All India Institute of Speech and Hearing (AIISH), Mysore in the year 2008. This center aims to overcome geographical constraints for the delivery of professional services and to provide rehabilitative & educational services to persons with communication disorders who cannot access the services offered at AIISH or other institutes offering similar services in the country. The Center works with the motto of 'Reaching the Unreached' through various information and Communication Technology (ICT) modes such as videoconferencing, website, Google group, Skype, e-mails and other interactive virtual modes to provide tele-assessment and tele-intervention to persons with communication disorders.

TCPD Objectives

- Development & dissemination of resource materials (in print and e-mode) in English and Indian languages
- Tele-assessment and Tele-intervention
- Helpline for senior citizens with communication disorders
- Educational guidance for children with communication disorders

Service Delivery

Tele-Orientation
 Apprises through tele orientation programs conducted for personnel, allied professionals, individuals with communication disorders and their caregivers.

Tele-assessment
 TCPD has the provision for testing individuals with communication disorder through ICT.

Tele-intervention
 The Center offers speech language therapy through Videoconferencing/Skype/Website and also conveys resource material required for rehabilitation online.

Educational Guidance
 Children with communication disorders are tested for their readiness to attend schools and related educational institutions and provided with Educational Guidance required for their child with communication disorders.

Resource Material for caregivers (Books, Multimedia Content, Websites)
 Resource materials for care givers to train their child at home are available in print and e-mode.

Helpline for senior citizens with communication disorders
 The center has a helpline for Persons with Parkinson's Disease. The main features of the helpline are frequently asked questions (FAQs), easy test forms and availability of treatment guidelines.

Research activities currently under progress
 Center conducts need based research in tele-rehabilitation and education.
